For **cross country** ski enthusiasts Bohart Ranch grooms 30 kilometers of quality XC ski trails appropriate for both the recreational and competitive skier on private and Forest Service terrain. <https://bridgerbowl.com/mountain-and-town/cross-country>

Snowflake lift and the new Snowflake Hut offer beginning skiers and riders a fantastic area to learn. Bridger has 2,000 acres of terrain at a maximum of 8,700 feet. Average annual snowfall is 350 inches! There are over 75 runs (longest 3 miles) served by 8 lifts. With four large bowls within the boundaries, the ski area offers wide-open terrain with a variety of landscapes including long, wide-open slopes, glades, chutes and gullies. Generally speaking, the ski area offers first-time beginner slopes in the base area, novice terrain across the lower middle, wide-open intermediate runs in the center, advanced open bowl terrain in the upper third and, finally, expert terrain coming off the ridge top. Expect moderate temperatures and high chance of fresh snow!
