

# **FAT BIKE POLICY REGINA SKI CLUB**

## **December 6, 2016**

RSC acknowledges that under **low tire pressures & solid snow conditions**, fat bike trail damage is minimal & possibly acceptable. However, the concern is that visible tire marks will encourage other non-skier traffic, particularly pedestrian/dog activity, especially in the city. The other concern is enforcement of biker compliance to Fat Bike Best Practices as posted on the IMBA website.

Until further notice, the following is the policy for Fat Bikes on groomed xc ski trails maintained by the Regina Ski Club (RSC). For trail conditions, location & trail maps see [reginaskiclub.com](http://reginaskiclub.com) under trail conditions.

### **White Butte Trails**

Allowed on winter hiking & snowshoe trails ONLY.  
NOT allowed on xc ski trails.

### **Wascana Park**

Allowed on skate lanes for special events only, when approved by Wascana Centre Authority (WCA) & RSC.

### **Douglas Park**

Not allowed.

### **Kinsmen Park**

Allowed on walking trail, adjacent to skate lanes, only.

### **Les Sherman Park**

Allowed on skate lanes.

### **A E Wilson Park**

Allowed on skate lane.

The RSC is prepared to work with local Fat Bike Clubs on a “trial & error” basis to gradually introduce fat bike activity on groomed xc ski trails. These trails are maintained, at considerable expense, by the RSC in partnership with Saskatchewan Parks, WCA & City of Regina.
